He led GetActive's merger with Convio; then as Convio's President built a company that had a highly successful IPO and was acquired for \$325 million. RVP led three rounds of financing for GetActive and Convio and served on the Board.

Sheeraz has also worked as a strategy consultant for McKinsey & Company, an entrepreneur-in-residence (EIR) for El Dorado Ventures, and an operations executive for GMO LLC. Sheeraz launched his career as an environmental engineer with Environ International. Sheeraz earned Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees in environmental engineering from Brown University and Stanford University respectively.
